

Crochet Bilby By J. McMahon 2014

I think I used 8ply wool in grey and pink.

Use small amount of black wool and white wool.

Notes:

-- sc (single crochet)

--ch (chain stitch)

-- **sc2tog** (a decrease made by crocheting two stitches together)

BODY

Use grey wool.

Row 1: Work 6 sc into a magic loop (6)

Row 2: Work 2 sc in each stitch (12)

Row 3: (Work 1 sc in first stitch, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 6x (18)

Row 4: (Work 1 sc in next 3 stitches, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 6x (24)

Row 5: (Work 1 sc in next 4 stitches, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 6x (30)

Row 6: (Work 1 sc in next 5 stitches, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 6x (36)

Row 7: (Work 1 sc in first stitch, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 3x, then sc all around (39)

Row 8 – 12: Sc all the way around (39)

Row 13: (sc2tog, work 1 sc in next 9 stitches, sc2tog) repeat 3x (33)

Row 14 - 20: Sc all the way around (33)

Row 21: (sc2tog, work 1 sc in next 3 stitches, sc2tog, work 1 sc in next 4 stitches) repeat 3x (27)

Row 22: Sc all the way around (27)

Row 23: (Work 1 sc, sc2tog) repeat 6x (18)

Row 24: Sc all the way around (18)

Fasten off.

ARMS x 2

Use pink wool.

Row 1: Work 6 sc into a magic loop (6)

Row 2: (Work 1 sc in first stitch, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 3x (9)

Row 3: Change to grey wool, sc all around (9)

Stuff the arm tip.

Row 4: Work 3 sc, skip 3 stitches, work 3sc (6)

Row 5 – 9: Sc all around (6)



Fasten off.

LEGS x 2

Use grey wool.

Row 1: Work 6 sc into a magic loop (6)

Row 2: Work 2 sc in each stitch (12)

Row 3: (Work 1 sc in first stitch, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 6x (18)

Row 4: (Work 1 sc in next 3 stitches, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 6x (24)

Row 5: (Work 1 sc in next 4 stitches, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 6x (30)

Row 6: (Work 1 sc in next 5 stitches, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 6x (36)

Row 7: sc2tog all around (18)

Fasten off.

FEET x 2

Use pink wool.

Row 1: Ch 14

Row 2: Work in both sides of the chain. Start in 2nd chain from hook, sc in next 12 stitches, 3sc in next stitch, sc in next 11 stitches, 2sc in last stitch (28)

Row 3: 2sc in next stitch, sc in next 13 stitches, 2sc in next 2 stitches, sc in next 12 stitches, 2sc in last stitch (32)

Row 4: Change to grey wool, sc all around (32)

Row 5: sc in next 12 stitches, (sc2tog) repeat 4x, sc in next 12 stitches (28)

Row 6: sc in next 10 stitches, (sc2tog) repeat 4x, sc in next 10 stitches (24)

Fasten off.

HEAD

Use grey wool.

Row 1: Work 6 sc into a magic loop (6)

Row 2: Work 2 sc in each stitch (12)

Row 3: (Work 1 sc in first stitch, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 6x (18)

Row 4: (Work 1 sc in next 3 stitches, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 6x (24)

Row 5: (Work 1 sc in next 4 stitches, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 6x (30)

Row 6: (Work 1 sc in next 5 stitches, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 6x (36)

Row 7: (Work 1 sc in first stitch, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 3x, then sc all around (39)

Row 8 – 11: Sc all the way around (39)

Row 12: (sc in next 11 stitches, sc2tog) repeat 3x (36)

Row 13: sc around (36)

Row 14: (sc in next 4 stitches, sc2tog) repeat 6x (30)

Row 15: (sc in next 2 stitches, sc2tog) repeat 7x, then sc in last 2 stitches (23)

Row 16: sc2tog, then sc around (22)

Row 17: (sc in next stitch, sc2tog) repeat 7x, sc in last stitch (15)

Row 18 – 20: sc all around (15)

Row 21: sc2tog, then sc around (14)

Row 22: sc all round (14)

Change to pink wool.

Row 23: sc2tog, sc in next 10 stitches, sc2tog (12)

Row 24: (sc in next stitch, sc2tog) repeat 4x (8)

Row 25: sc in next 3 stitches, sc2tog, sc in last 3 stitches (7)

Row 26: sc all around (7)

Fasten off.

I seem to have written down an alternate ending to the head and I don't know which one I used.

Row 24 – 26: sc all around (12)

Row 27: sc2tog all around (6)

Fasten off.

EARS x 2

Use grey wool.

Row 1: Work 4 sc into a magic loop (4)

Row 2: (Work 1 sc in first stitch, 2 sc in next stitch) repeat 2x (6)

Row 3: (sc in next 2 stitches, 2sc in next stitch) repeat 2x (8)

Row 4: (sc in next 3 stitches, 2sc in next stitch) repeat 2x (10)

Row 5: (sc in next 4 stitches, 2sc in next stitch) repeat 2x (12)

Row 6: sc all around (12)

Row 7: (sc in next 5 stitches, 2sc in next stitch) repeat 2x (14)

Row 8: (sc in next 6 stitches, 2sc in next stitch) repeat 2x (16)

Row 9: (sc in next 7 stitches, 2sc in next stitch) repeat 2x (18)

Row 10: (sc in next 8 stitches, 2sc in next stitch) repeat 2x (20)

Row 11: (sc in next 9 stitches, 2sc in next stitch) repeat 2x (22)

Row 12 – 13: sc all around (22)

Row 14: (sc in next 9 stitches, sc2tog) repeat 2x (20)

Row 15: (sc in next 8 stitches, sc2tog) repeat 2x (18)

Row 16: (sc in next 7 stitches, sc2tog) repeat 2x (16)

Row 17: sc all around (16)

Fasten off.

TAIL

Use grey wool.

Row 1: Work 6 sc into a magic loop (6)

Row 2: (sc in next stitch, 2sc in next stitch) repeat 3x (9)

Row 3: sc all around (9)

Row 4: sc in next 3 stitches, sc2tog, then sc in next 4 stitches (8)

Row 5: sc2tog, then sc in next 6 stitches (7)

Row 6: sc in next 5 stitches, sc2tog (6)

Row 7 – 12: sc all around (6)

Change to black wool.

Row 13 – 16: sc all around (6)

Change to white wool.

Row 17: sc all around (6)

Row 18: 2sc in next stitch, then sc in next 6 stitches (7)

Row 19: sc in next 3 stitches, 2sc in next stitch, sc in next 3 stitches (8)

Row 20: sc in next 7 stitches, 2sc in last stitch (9)

Row 21 – 22: sc all around (9)

Row 23: sc2tog, then sc in next 6 stitches (8)

Row 24: sc in next 3 stitches, sc2tog, then sc in last 3 stitches (7)

Row 25: sc in next 5 stitches, sc2tog (6)

Row 26: sc in next 2 stitches, sc2tog, sc in last 2 stitches (5)

Row 27: sc2tog, sc in last 3 stitches (4)

Row 28: sc2tog, sc in last 2 stitches (3)

Row 29: sc all around (3)

Fasten off.
