





Create an Easter Bilby Parade Mask

The Save the Bilby Fund is an Australian registered charity. Our conservation work includes captive breeding programs, wild bilby research and protection, the monitoring of the bilby sanctuary in Currawinya National Park, and school and community education.

Our focus is to build an insurance population of 10,000 bilbies in Australia by 2030, in support of a National Recovery Plan for the species.
